 The Game Changers Initiative offers academic success coaching to first-generation scholars through the first year success center. Students are connected to an individual success coach, provided with networking opportunities, and connected with other ASU first-generation students, professors, and leaders.



 First generation students enrolled in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences can apply to the list of scholarships provided on the site. Students can submit their applications through <u>ASU's</u> <u>Scholarship Portal</u>.



 RiseFirst is an online platform that provides lists of support resources and mentorship opportunities for first-generation students.
They have a curated <u>directory</u> with over 1,200 resources designed for first-gen students.
