

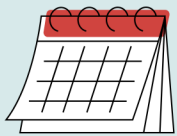
# Tips for Developing a Research Schedule with Low- Income Students

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Students may encounter unexpected barriers or emergencies that sometimes interfere with their research. When feasible, offer opportunities for students to “make up” that research time later!

## ESTABLISH A CLEAR WORK SCHEDULE

Create a work schedule that accommodates students' transportation, employment, and academic needs.

If it is feasible in your research lab, provide remote research opportunities or allow students to determine their own flexible research hours.

## PROVIDE REMOTE RESEARCH OPPORTUNITIES



## DON'T ASK STUDENTS TO COME IN "OVERTIME"

Avoid asking students to come into the lab outside of their predetermined schedule, as this can be a particularly large burden for low-income students.

When capable, provide transportation to remote research sites or plan to carpool.
